Red Wines

Cabernet Sauvignon 2018:

Estate grown with blended aging in both French and American oak barrels for over 24 months; provides an array of smooth flavors such as blueberry, mocha, plum and vanilla, with aromas of chocolat, plum and a hint of vanilla.

Aglianico 2017:

This is an estate grown full-bodied red wine, which is found almost exclusively in Southern Italy. Aglianico is known for firm tannins and higher acidity. This deep garnet colored wine has aromas of blueberry, vanilla and cassis.

Syrah "Rock Creek" 2017:

Our most beautiful Syrah to date with notes of chocolate and caramel. This Syrah has full-bodied taste with a smooth lingering finish. This Syrah has aromas of blackberries on the palate.

Montepulciano 2018:

This estate grown grape is notorious for inky dark colors with big structure, low acidity and long-lasting finishes. Notice aromatics consisting of cassis, smoke, and a hint of vanilla. Flavors are earthy with blackberries, ripe cherries and smooth tannins.

Late Harvest 2002:

This late harvest port is comprised of 56% Zinfandel, 23% Grenache, and 21% Alicante. Aged in red wood for one year and American oak for 17 years. This beautiful tawny colored late harvest exhibits a bouquet of caramel, raisin and vanilla on the nose.

Albariño:

This is a green skinned grape varietal native to Galicia grown on the North Atlantic coast of Spain. Albariño exhibits aromas of passion fruit, banana, peach and melon.
